

**Television (Video) Production

Contest Description:

Teams of two contestants are required to shoot and edit a one-minute video on location conveying the assigned theme. Editing is done in the contest area with special emphasis on professional production of the video by industry standards, quality of audio and video, and adequate conveyance of the theme to the viewer.

Supplied by the contestants:

One camera per team	Audio equipment*	Batteries for production equipment	Blank recording media

***This requirement, if not met, will result in a point deduction on the team's final judging sheet.*

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****Music MUST be chosen from the selections provided to the contestant teams by the committee chair. No other music will be allowed regardless of rights or ownership.*

Clothing Requirement:

Contestants are required to wear SkillsUSA Class E: Contest Specific-Business Casual Attire during the pre-contest meeting on Thursday and during the contest on Friday.

For Men: Official SkillsUSA white polo shirt****, black dress slacks, black socks, black leather shoes.

For Women: Official SkillsUSA white polo shirt***** with black dress skirt (knee-length) or black slacks; black socks or black or skin- tone seamless hose; black leather dress shoes.

*****Participants may wear red SkillsUSA Polo in place of official SkillsUSA white polo shirt. All other accessories are required.*

Pre-Contest Meeting:

It is the expectation that all teams attend the pre-contest meeting and that **both** team members are present. During the pre-contest meeting the PDP test will be administered. If a student competitor will not be in attendance of the pre-contest meeting due to a valid reason, it is the responsibility of the student's advisor to contact the contest chair **prior to** the pre-contest meeting. Valid reasons are: during the time of the pre-contest meeting a student is competing in a SkillsUSA written or leadership contest or the student is participating in either a MSHSAA sanctioned or Missouri CTSO event. Contest chair contact information is listed at the end of this document.

Video Submission:

Teams will be required to export their finished video using the H.264 codec. Please understand how to perform this function from within your editing software. The file will then be copied from the team's computer to an external drive provided by the committee for viewing by the judging panel.
